They moved from Alexanderthal, Molotschna to Gnadenheim, Barnaul. In Canada they lived in Osborne, MB., then to Dunrea, MB. They were married for 24 years and 10 days. One source says she was bom in Fuerstenwerder.

7. **Maria Rempel**,² #266514, b. 25 Oct 1876 in Blumstein, Molotschna, South Russia,^{11,19} d. 6 Feb 1964 in Abbotsford, British Columbia,^{11,19} buried 8 Feb 1964 in Abbotsford, British Columbia.¹⁹ Maria's parents moved from Blumstein, Mol. to Spat, Crimea. 1893 to Donskoye, Neu Samara. Jacob & Maria 1910 to Gnadenheim, Barnaul. 1926 in fall to Canada, to Drake, SK for 2 years, to Margaret, MB for 12 years., 1940 to Abbotsford, BC. They had 12 children, 2 sons died in infancy, 2 sons died at age 2 years. Surviving are 3 sons & 3 daughters.

EWZ says she was bom 8 Apr 1852 at Fuerstenwerder. Another record says she was born 8 Apr 1859 at Margenu. Mennonite Historian says she was bom 1857.
12. **Jacob Wedel**,^{107,108} #988972, b.¹⁰⁹ He married **Katharina Dueck**,¹¹⁰ #1197724.

He married (2) **Katharina Funk** #286963, 1868, b. 1 Jun 1847 in Prangenu Molotschna, South Russia,¹²³ d. 22 Oct 1874 in Prangenu, Molotschna, South Russia.¹²⁴

18. **Peter Riediger**,^{125,126} #266450, b. 17 Jun 1810 in Zieglershuben, Stuhm, Prussia,^{127,128} d. 24 May 1872,¹²⁹ immigrated 1818 in Lichtfelde, Molotschna, South Russia.¹³⁰ The Margareta Riediger and Hilda Riediger submissions say he was bom 4 June 1809. The Hilda Riediger submission says that he was bom at Lichtfelde, Molotschna, but the Tragheimerweide Church records disagree. He married (1) **Elisabeth Wiebe**,¹³¹ #102420.¹³² He married (2) **Aganetha Harder**,¹³³ #101802, b. Abt 1823 in Neukirch, Molotschna, South Russia, Aganetha Harder's first marriage was to a Loewen with whom she had four children (according to the "Genealogy of Abraham Riediger"; no dates). The 1857-58 Lichtfelde School Register lists the following children of Peter Riediger: Aganetha, 11, Peter 9, Katharina 9, and Katharina 6; no Loewens. 1861-2: Agnetha 10, Maria 8, Jacob 6; no Loewens; no school in Neukirch.

20. **Isaac Abraham Toews**,²² #51737, b. 30 Oct 1817 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{38,39} d. 1892 in Fuerstenwerder, Molotschna, South Russia. He married **Maria Engbrecht** #266495.
21. **Maria Engbrecht** #266495, b.²⁴ d. in Fuerstenwerder, Molotschna, South Russia.
22. **Abraham Klassen**,⁴⁰ #51822, b. Abt 1821. He married (1) **Helena Kornelson** #238919. He married (2) _____ **Willems**,⁴⁰ #1093483.

28. **Isbrandt Rempel** #467406, b. 19 Nov 1802.^{41,42} In the 1835 census, he is listed at Schoenau #14, the home of his father. He married (1) **Elizabeth Rempel** #467410, b. 17 Sep 1809, d. 29 May 1835, Her surname might not be Rempel. He married (2) **Agatha DeFehr**,⁴³ #60916, 20 Aug 1835.
29. **Agatha DeFehr**,⁴³ #60916, b. 24 Jun 1815 in Blumstein, Molotschna, South Russia.

32. **Heinrich Daniel Suderman**,⁴⁴ #313770, b. 2 Aug 1788 in **Koldau, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{36,45,46} d. 1842 in South Russia.⁴⁵ In the 1835 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed at Orloff #5, the home of David and Heinrich Cornies, the brothers of the renowned Johann Cornies. The entry says he came to Russia in 1811 and that he went back to Prussia, eventually returning to Russia in 1820. From "A Mennonite Heritage. A Genealogy of the Suderman and Wiens Families, 1800-1975 by Carolyn L. Zeisset. He married **Adelgunda Penner** #315407, 1825 in South Russia.⁴⁷
33. **Adelgunda Penner** #315407, b. 18 Jul 1805 in Muntau, Molotschna, South Russia,^{48,45,49} d. 15 Apr 1888 in Hillsboro, Kansas,⁴⁵ buried in Gnadenau, Marion County, Kansas. Originally buried on the Jost farm. Her surname is given as Funk on the ship passenger list in 1877, likely since she immigrated with Peter Funk and Katharina Dyck and their family. She married (1) **Heinrich Daniel Suderman**,⁴⁴ #313770, 1825 in South Russia.⁴⁷ She married (2) **Klaas Dueck** #37508, Abt 1842 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia,⁵⁰ b. 11 Sep 1818 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{50,46,51,52} d. 16 Aug 1869 in Prangenu, Molotschna, South Russia,⁵⁰ buried 19 Aug 1869 in South Russia, His o.s. birth date was 31 Aug 1818. Bruderthal p. 62: "aus Prangenu")
36. **Abraham Riediger**,^{1,2,53} #266448, b. 22 Feb 1782 in Prussia.⁵⁴ He resided in **Ellerwald, Prussia** at the time of his baptism. He migrated from Prussia to Lichtfelde, Molotschna Colony in 1818 (P. Rempel, p. 113). The Abraham Riediger Genealogy, p. 5, says that the family immigrated to Russia from **Ziegiershube, near Stuhm (Sztum), West Prussia**. In the 1835 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed at Lichtfelde #11. Lichtfelde was established in 1819. The family lived on the west side at the south end of the village. He was the administrator (Schulze) of the village in 1819. The "Land Disposals by Mennonites in the Marienwerder District, 1803-1856" document (A. Goertz) records an Abr. Riediger of **Zieglershuben/Stuhm**, but no date is given. He married (1) **Sara Pinckler**,⁵⁵ #283247, b. 23 Aug 1782 in **Montauerweide. Stuhm. Prussia**,^{56,57} d. 8 Feb 1831 in **Budizin. Stuhm. Prussia**,⁵⁷ Her daughter Anna was born out of wedlock. **Tragneimerweide** records, page 285: died age 58Y 1 IM. According to the Tragheimerweide records, daughter Sara Penner was also bom out of wedlock. He married (2) **Anna Kroeker**,^{2,33} #62852, 24 Sep 1807.
37. **Anna Kroeker**,^{2,33} #62852, b. 17 Aug 1782 in Prussia.^{54,58} The "1776 Census of Mennonites in West Prussia" has two Kroeker families in **Zieglershuben**: Michael Kroeker and family and Martin Kroeker and

family. Anna Kroeker, bom 1782, is very probably the daughter of one of these two Kroekers in **Zieglershuben** (and possibly the granddaughter of the other).

38. **Jacob Jacob Wiebe** #46899, b. Abt 1791 in Prussia,^{36,59,60,61} d. Abt 1839 in Prangenau, Molotschna, South Russia. The 1814 Molotschna records say he was an Einwohner at Blumenort #5 in May 1814, when his son Jacob was bom. In July 1814, he, along with wife Katharina and son Jacob, took over Blumenort #3 from Johann Warkentin. In the 1835 Molotschna Census he is listed at Prangenau #7, where it says he came to Russia in 1804 and moved to Prangenau from Blumenort in 1829, which is confirmed at the entry for Blumenort #23. His second wife Aganetha Rogalsky was likely related to Heinrich Rogalsky (b. ca 1769) #46467, whose family is listed at Blumenort #23 in the 1835 Census. He migrated from **Zeyersvorderkampen, Prussia** to Russia in 1827 and settled in Sparrau, Molotschna Colony in 1828 (P. Rempel, p. 203, 208). In the 1835 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed him at Lichtfelde #3, where it says he came to Russia in 1827 and moved to Lichtfelde from Sparrau in 1829. This is confirmed by the entry for him at Sparrau #42. A servant, Anna Sawatzki, age 19, also immigrated with his family in 1827. He married (1) **Katharina**_____ #808377. He married (2) **Agneta Rogalske** #62620, Abt 1817. He married (3) **Sarah Tieszen**,³⁰ #36260, 1831, b. 12 Feb 1811 in Lichtfelde, Molotschna, South Russia,⁶² d. 26 Feb 1855 in Prangenau, Molotschna, South Russia,⁶² Her n.s. birth date was 24 Feb 1811. She was from the village of Prangenau, Molotschna. Her first husband was Jacob Wiebe.
39. **Agneta Rogalske** #62620, b. Abt 1803,³⁶ d. Abt 1830. Could this be the same person as Anganetha Rogalsky (b. ca 1796) #46480?
40. **Abraham Toews** #51732, b. 12 Jul 1781 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{10,46,63,38} d. 1826 in Fuerstenau, Molotschna, South Russia,^{64,36} buried in Fuerstenau, Molotschna, South Russia. He was a minister in the **Heuboden Mennonite Church** in W. Prussia (B. H. Unruh, p. 371). He migrated from **Heuboden, Prussia** to the Molotschna Colony in 1823 (P. Rempel, p. 189, 196; B. H. Unruh, p. 371). Peter Rempel's book inexplicably says that he settled in both Fuerstenau and Friedensdorf in the Molotschna Colony in 1823 (P. Rempel, p. 196). Possibly he initially settled in Friedensdorf and moved shortly thereafter to Fuerstenau. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Fuerstenau #20 says he came to Russia in 1823 and died in 1826. While the entry indicates that his father was Abraham Toews, the Martin Toews book says his father was an Isaak Toews. I think the census incorrectly used the name of son Abraham. B. H. Unruh, p. 371, says he married Elizabeth Warkentin 11 May 1805. One record says he was bom 17 July. One family record says he died Spring, 1827. His passport, dated 26 June/8 July 1823, says he came from **Heubuden**. He married **Elisabeth Warkentin** #51733, 9 May 1805 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{65,46,66,67}
41. **Elisabeth Warkentin** #51733, b. 29 Mar 1783 in **Kunzendorf, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{46,38} d. 1848 in Fuerstenau, Molotschna, South Russia. The **Kunzendorf** Marriage record indicates her first marriage occurred on 9 Mar. She married (1) **Abraham Toews** #51732, 9 May 1805 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{65,46,66,67} She married (2) **Peter Michael Regier** #46353, 1827 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia, b. Abt 1805 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia, In the 1835 census, he is listed at Fuerstenau #20, and is said to have come to the Molotschna in 1805. He moved to Fuerstenau in 1823 from Ladekop, Molotschna, which is confirmed by the entry for Ladekop #1.
44. **Abraham Cornelius Klaassen** #44037, b. Abt 1790.^{68,69,36} In the 1835 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed at Fuerstenwerder #9, where it says that he came to Russia in 1810, transferred from Lichtenau to Fuerstenwerder in 1826. This is confirmed by the entry for him at Lichtenau #32. He married **Anna Wiebe** #46844, 8 May 1813.⁷⁰

45. **Anna Wiebe** #46844, b. 7 Aug 1794,³⁶ d. 15 Feb 1836 in Fuerstenwerder, Molotschna, South Russia.
56. **Isebrandt Isebrandt Rempel**,⁷¹ #46436, b. Abt 1782.⁴¹ He migrated from **Krebsfelde, Prussia** to the Molotschna Colony, S. Russia in 1804 with his brother Jacob (P. Rempel, p. 88). His first name is incorrectly given as Johann in the 1804 immigration list in Peter Rempel's book. In the 1808 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed at Tiegenhagen #10, and is said to have come from Mausdorf, Prussia (B. H. Unruh, p. 323). In the 1835 Molotschna Census he is listed at Schoenau #14, and is said to have come to Russia in 1804 and to have moved to Schoenau from Tiegenhagen in 1818. This is confirmed by the 1835 Molotschna Census entry for him at Tiegenhagen #23. He married (1) **Helena** _____ #46437. He married (2) **Katharina Peters** #45848, b. Abt 1767.
57. **Helena** _____ #46437, b. Abt 1777.⁴¹
58. **Johann Cornelius DeFehr**,⁴³ #44165, b. Abt 1776 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{36,72} d. 1822 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia. He was residing in **Simonsdorf, Prussia** at the time of his baptism in 1796. In the 1808 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed at Schoenau #12 (B. H. Unruh, p. 309). The census says that he came from **Czattkau, Prussia**. Unruh (p. 345) says that Cornelius DeFehr (#44522), his brother, travelled to the Molotschna with him. In the 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Schoenau #27, it is said that he moved away from there in 1820 and that he was the son of Cornelius DeFehr. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Blumstein #1 says he came to Russia in 1803, moved to Blumstein in 1820, and died in 1822. He was then married to an Anna _____, so she may be the mother of some of his children! He married (1) **Maria Enz**,⁴³ #44166. He married (2) **Anna** _____ #60918, b. Abt 1793, She may be the mother of some of the DeFehr children bom after the 1808 census. However, I have listed them all under the first wife for convenience' sake. Could this be the same person as #275141?
59. **Maria Enz**,⁴³ #44166, b. Abt 1778.

64. **Daniel Sudermann**,⁷³ #266837, b. Abt 1756 in **Marienburg, Prussia**,⁴⁴d. 1818. Schulze und Grützmüller. One record says he died at **Kurau**. Given name konfirmed by examining copy of original 1835 Molotschna census. The Johann J. Sudermann book gives marriage date as 1783. He married **Agnetha Kroecker**,⁷³ #845019, 30 Oct 1780 in **Marienburg, Prussia**.
65. **Agnetha Kroecker**,⁷³ #845019, b. in **Ellerwald Trift 2, Elbing, Prussia**, d. 18 Jan 1830.
66. **Jacob Jacob Penner** #265507, b. Abt 1771,^{36,74,48,49} d. 1831 in Margenau, Molotschna, South Russia.³⁶ He migrated from **Neumuensterberg, Prussia** to the Molotschna Colony, S. Russia in 1803 (P. Rempel, p. 57; B. H. Unruh, p. 343). In the 1806 and 1808 Molotschna Colony Censuses he is listed at Muntau #8 (B. H. Unruh, p. 307). The 1808 Census says that he came from **Muensterberg, Prussia**. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Margenau #28 says he moved from Muntau to Margenau in 1824, and died in 1831. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Muntau #25 says that he moved from there to Margenau in 1824. He married **Adelgunda "Guncke" Conrad** #265508.
67. **Adelgunda "Guncke" Conrad** #265508, b. Abt 1770.^{74,48,49} Her age is given as 33 in the 1803 immigration in Peter Rempel's book Mennonite Migration to Russia, p. 57, suggesting that she was bom ca 1770. Her age is given as 38 in the 1806 Molotschna Colony Census, suggesting that she was bom ca 1768. Her age is given as 36 in the 1808 Census, suggesting that she was born ca 1772 (B. H. Unruh, p.

to the Molotschna Colony, S. Russia in 1803 (P. Rempel, p. 57; B. H. Unruh, p. 343). In the 1806 and 1808 Molotschna Colony Censuses he is listed at Muntau #8 (B. H. Unruh, p. 307). The 1808 Census says that he came from **Muensterberg, Prussia**. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Margenau #28 says he moved from Muntau to Margenau in 1824, and died in 1831. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Muntau #25 says that he moved from there to Margenau in 1824. He married **Adelgunda "Guncke" Conrad #265508**.

67. **Adelgunda "Guncke" Conrad #265508**, b. Abt 1770,^{242,243,244} immigrated 1803 in Molotschna Colony, South Russia.^{245,246} Her age is given as 33 in the 1803 immigration in Peter Rempel's book *Mennonite Migration to Russia*, p. 57, suggesting that she was bom ca 1770. Her age is given as 38 in the 1806 Molotschna Colony Census, suggesting that she was bom ca 1768. Her age is given as 36 in the 1808 Census, suggesting that she was born ca 1772 (B. H. Unruh, p. 307). Her age is given as 60 in the 1835 Molotschna Colony Census, suggesting that she was born ca 1775. Her first name is incorrectly given as Florgunda in the 1806 Census.
72. **Abraham Riediger**,^{247 248,249} #266901, b. Abt Feb 1746,²⁵⁰ d. 30 Sep 1822 in **Montauerweide, Stuhm, Prussia**.²⁵¹ **Tragheimerweide** records, page 276: died age 76Y 7M. He married _____ **Quiring #266902**.
73. _____ **Quiring #266902**, b. Abt 24 Jul 1750,²⁵² d. 14 May 1809 in **Zieglershuben, Stuhm, Prussia**.²⁵³ **Tragheimerweide** records, page 261: died age 58Y 9M 20D.
76. **Jacob Jacob Wiebe #46896**, b. Abt 1764,^{254,255} d. 1829 in Ohrloff, Molotschna, South Russia,²⁵⁶ immigrated 1804.^{257,258} He migrated from **Walldorf, Prussia** to the Molotschna Colony, S. Russia in 1804 (P. Rempel, p. 85; B. H. Unruh, p. 324, 353). In the 1808 Molotschna Colony Census he is listed at Ohrloff #8 (B. H. Unruh, p. 324). The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Orloff #8 says he died in 1829. He married **Elisabeth Neufeldt #46897**.
77. **Elisabeth Neufeldt #46897**, b. Abt 1764 in **Walldorf, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{259,260} d. Feb 1838 in Ohrloff, Molotschna, South Russia, immigrated 1804.^{261,262} Baptized into the **Rosenort** church and living in **Klein Mausdorferweide** at the time. She has not been located in the 1835 Molotschna Colony Census. Her marriage to marriage to Ensz is inconsistent with death of Wiebe in 1829. She married (1) **Jacob Jacob Wiebe #46896**. She married (2) **Heinrich Heinrich Ensz #44817**, b. Abt 1763, d. 1824 in Lichtenau, Molotschna, South Russia, In the 1808 census, he is listed at Lichtenau #21, and is said to have come from **Einlage, Prussia**. However, Unruh (p. 338) states that he came from **Robach, Prussia**. The 1835 Molotschna Census entry for Lichtenau #32 says he died there in 1824.
80. **Isaak Toews #132700**, b. Abt 1754 in **Koczelitzke, Gross Werder, Prussia**,^{263,264} d. 17 Feb 1803 in **Heubuden, Gross Werder, Prussia**.^{265,266} The Martin Toews book says that he was the father of Abraham Abraham Toews (b. 12 Jul 1781) #51732.
